

## Lesson Plan 2. Know Yourself: Preferences & Predilections

Target Grade(s)	9 <sup>th</sup> – 12 <sup>th</sup> grade
Essential Question	In what ways might your personal preferences and predilections influence your career pathway?
Learning Outcome(s)	<ol> <li>Students will gain a basic understanding of multiple intelligences.</li> <li>Students will better understand their personal preferences and predilections and how they factor into career choice.</li> </ol>

Materials	LCD Projector and screen, handouts x2, clothesline, clothespin for each student, wall signs, 2 chairs, newsprint or whiteboard, markers, copy of health careers and MI matching sheet, color dots or cones, tiny props in a bag
Teacher Preparation	Cue up the video, create the clothesline Likert Scale and post wall signs, make copies for each student of the Venn Diagram and Multiple Intelligences handouts, write the health careers on newsprint or whiteboard, place color dots on 3 corners of the room, gather tiny props for reflection
