

NURSING PROGRAMS IN VERMONT 2023



LPN to ADN and ADN to BSN

Practical Nursing Certificate and Nursing A.S. programs are located at multiple campuses and learning sites around Vermont and New Hampshire.

Option 1 - 4 year BSN at Castleton campus and Bennington learning site.

Option 2 - The career ladder approach is provided in a 1+1+2 model, which allows for the completion of the Practical Nursing Certificate, followed by the completion of the Associate of Science in Nursing (A.S.) leading to eligibility for RN licensure, and culminating with the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.S.N.).
